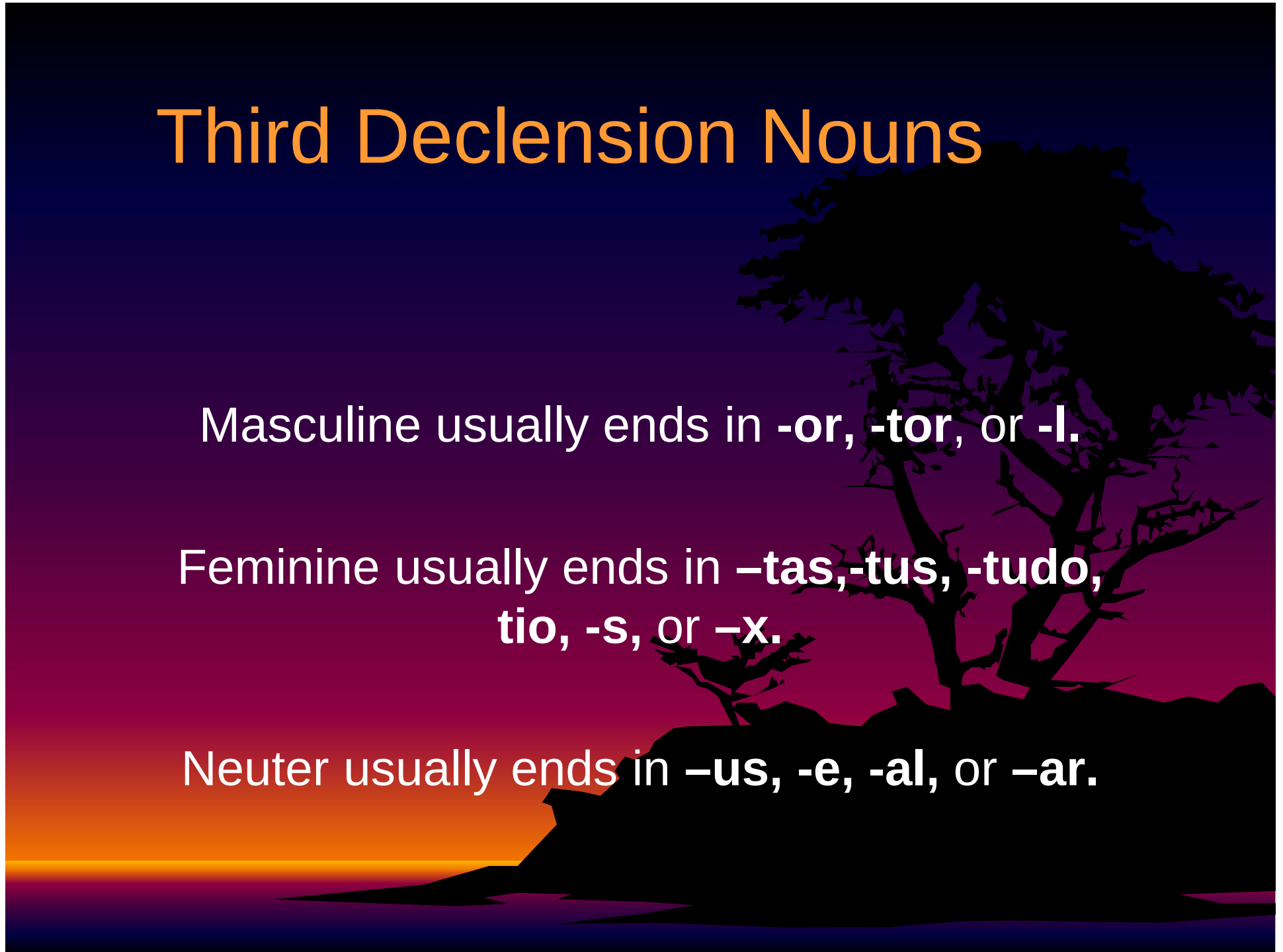

# Third Declension Nouns

Masculine usually ends in **-or, -tor, or -l.**

Feminine usually ends in **-tas, -tus, -tudo, tio, -s, or -x.**

Neuter usually ends in **-us, -e, -al, or -ar.**



# Endings for Third Declension Nouns - Singular

|                 |       |       |
|-----------------|-------|-------|
| Nominative case | ----- | ----- |
| Genitive case   | -is   | -is   |
| Dative case     | -i    | -i    |
| Accusative case | -em   | ----- |
| Ablative case   | -e    | -i    |

# Endings for Third Declension Nouns Plurals.

|-----------------|-------|-------|
| Nominative case | -es   | -a    |
| Genitive case   | -um   | -um   |
| Dative case     | -ibus | -ibus |
| Accusative case | -es   | -a    |
| Ablative case   | -ibus | -ibus |

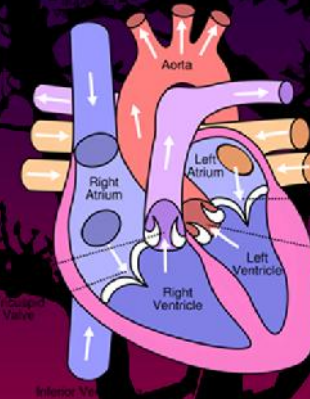

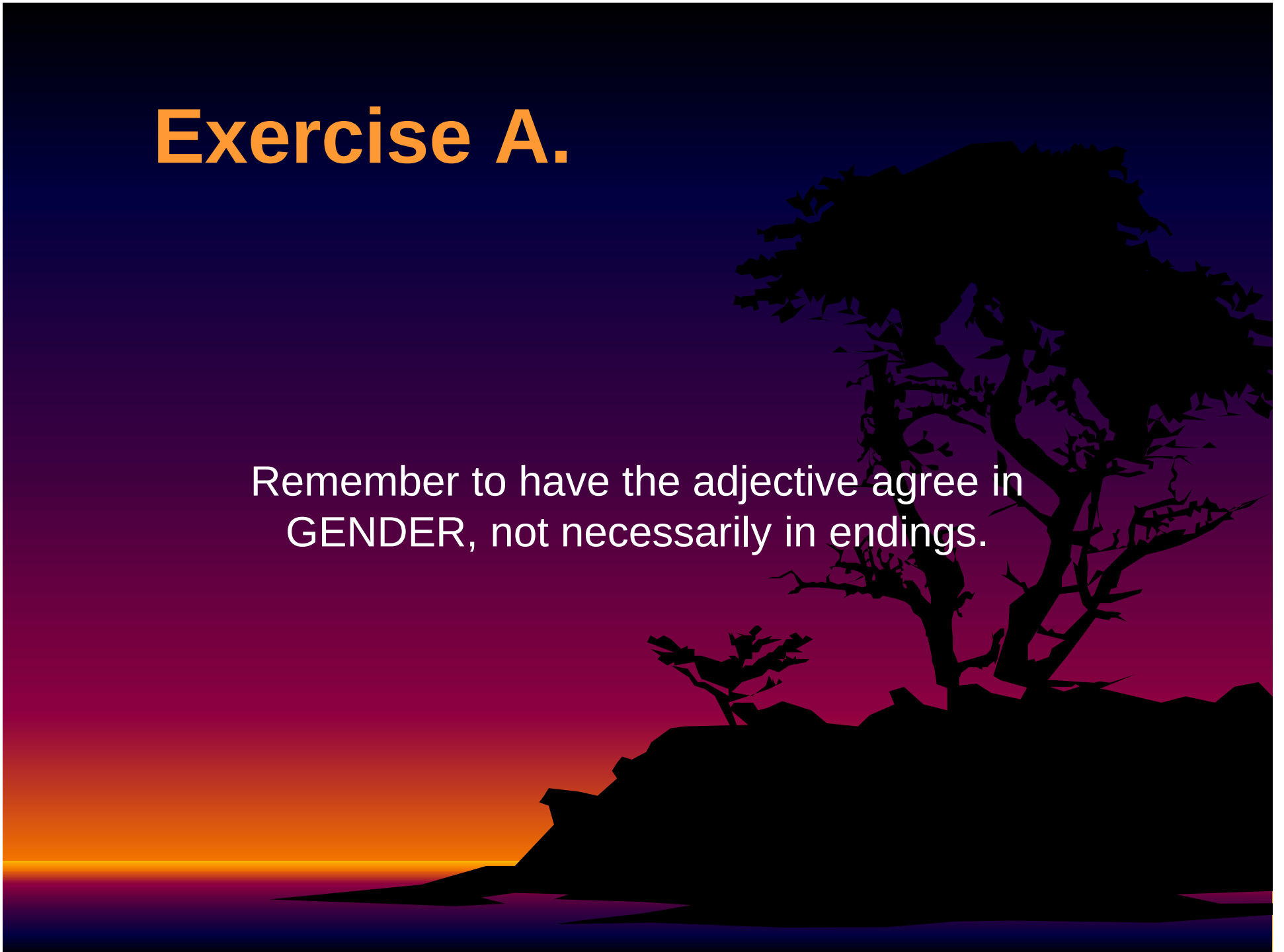

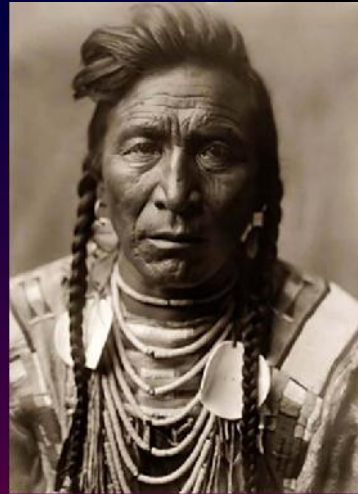
Example:

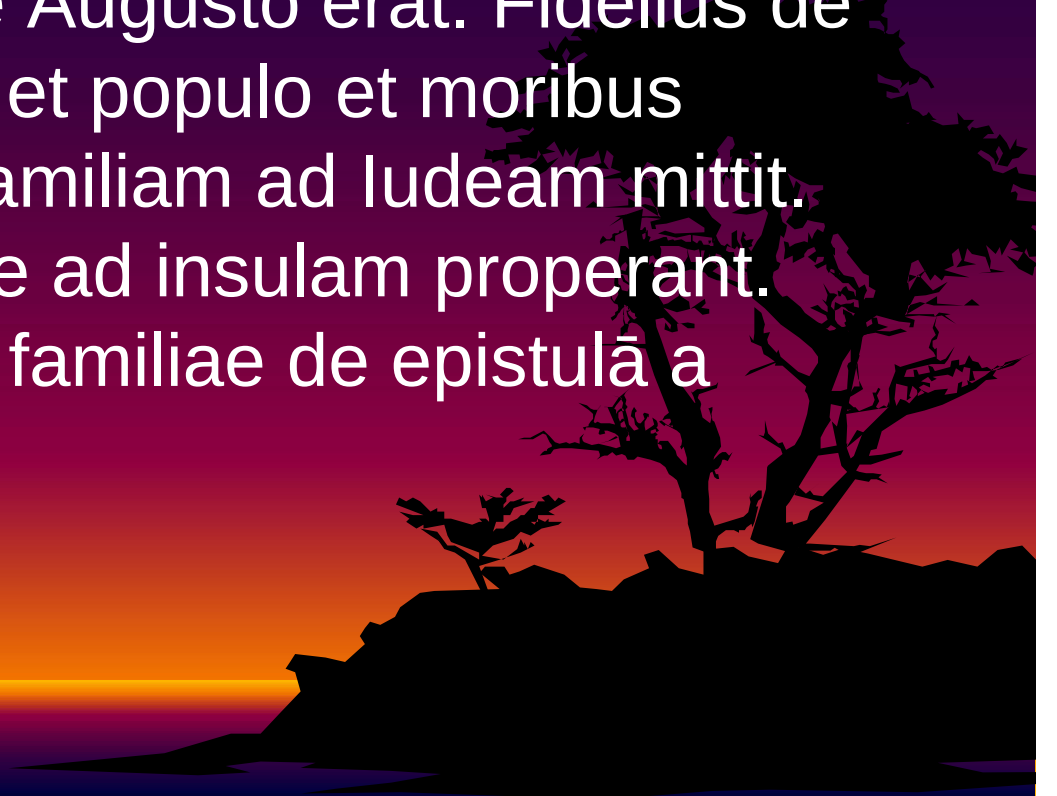
Unā die ubi Fidelius Ioannesque ad Praetoria Castra sunt, miles Fidelio epistulam dat.

Fidelius Ioannesque ad insulam properant. Sunt defessi. Fidelius familiae de epistulā a Tiberio narrare vult.



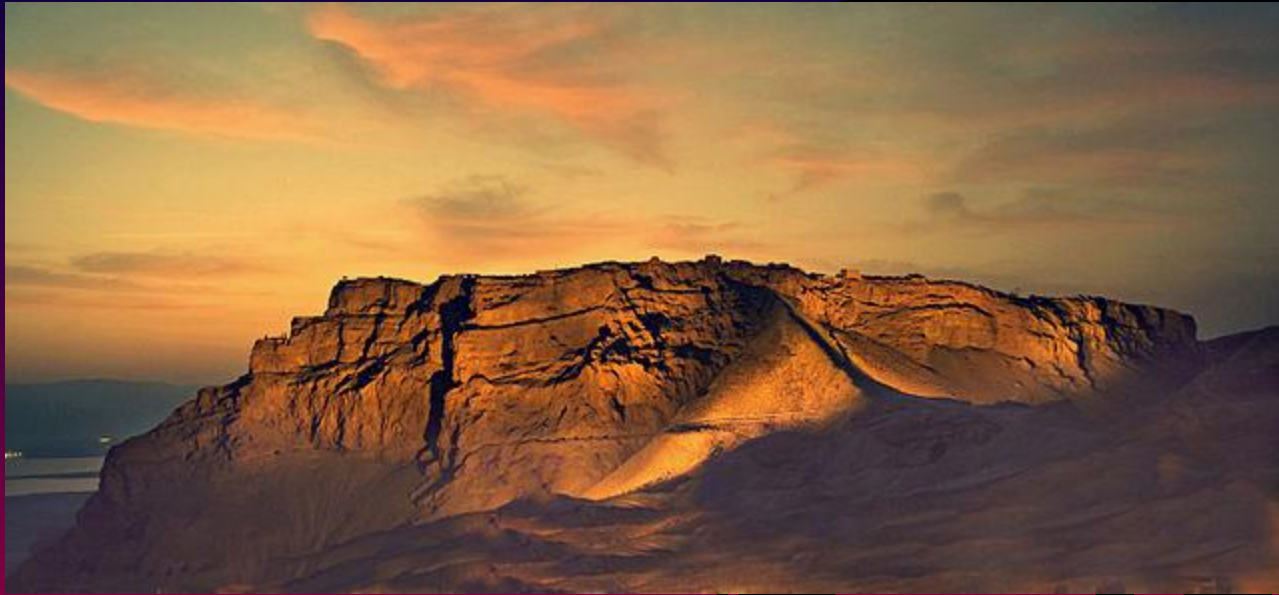
# Reporta ad Iudeam
