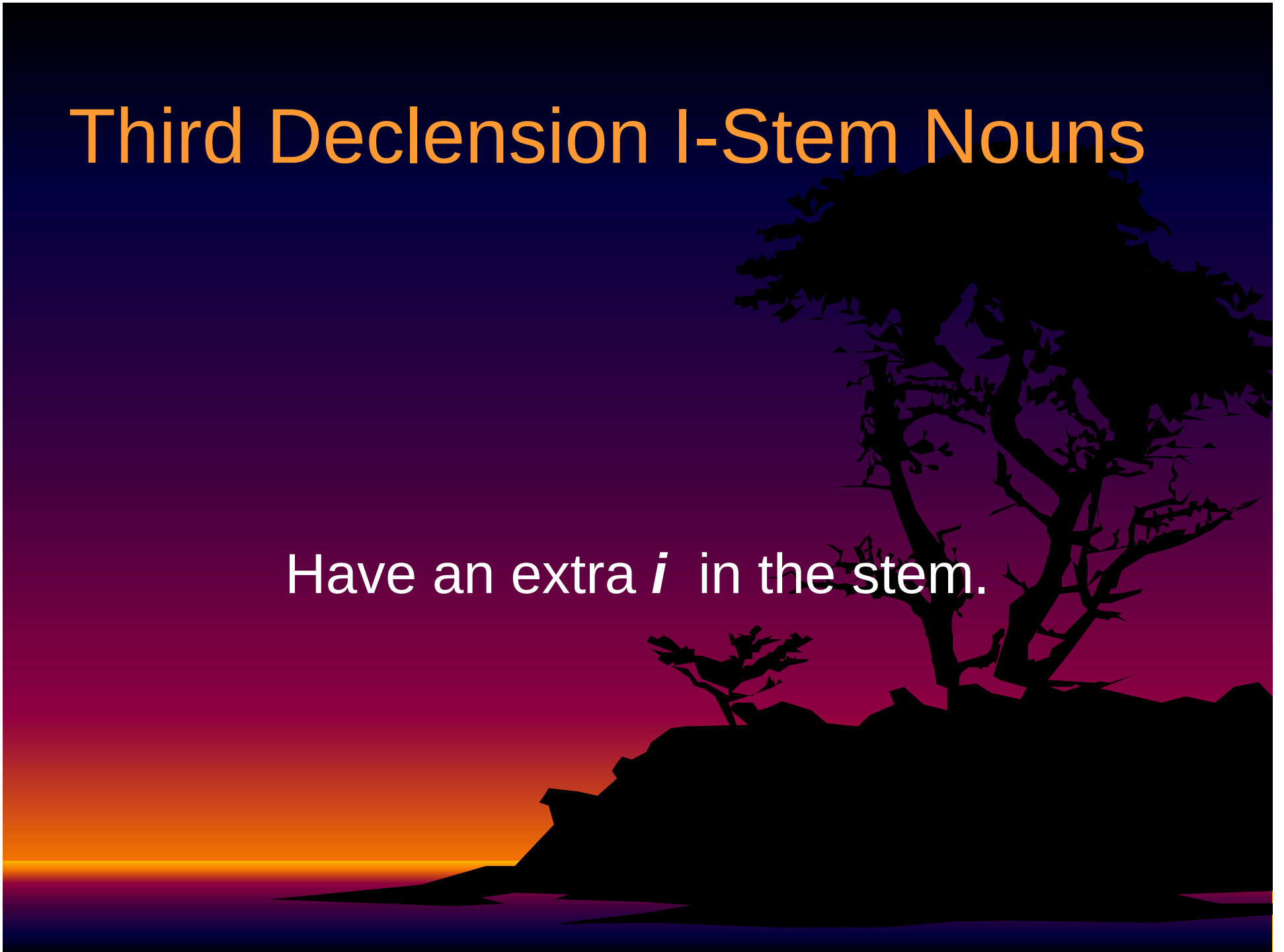

Plural Masculine and Feminine Neuter

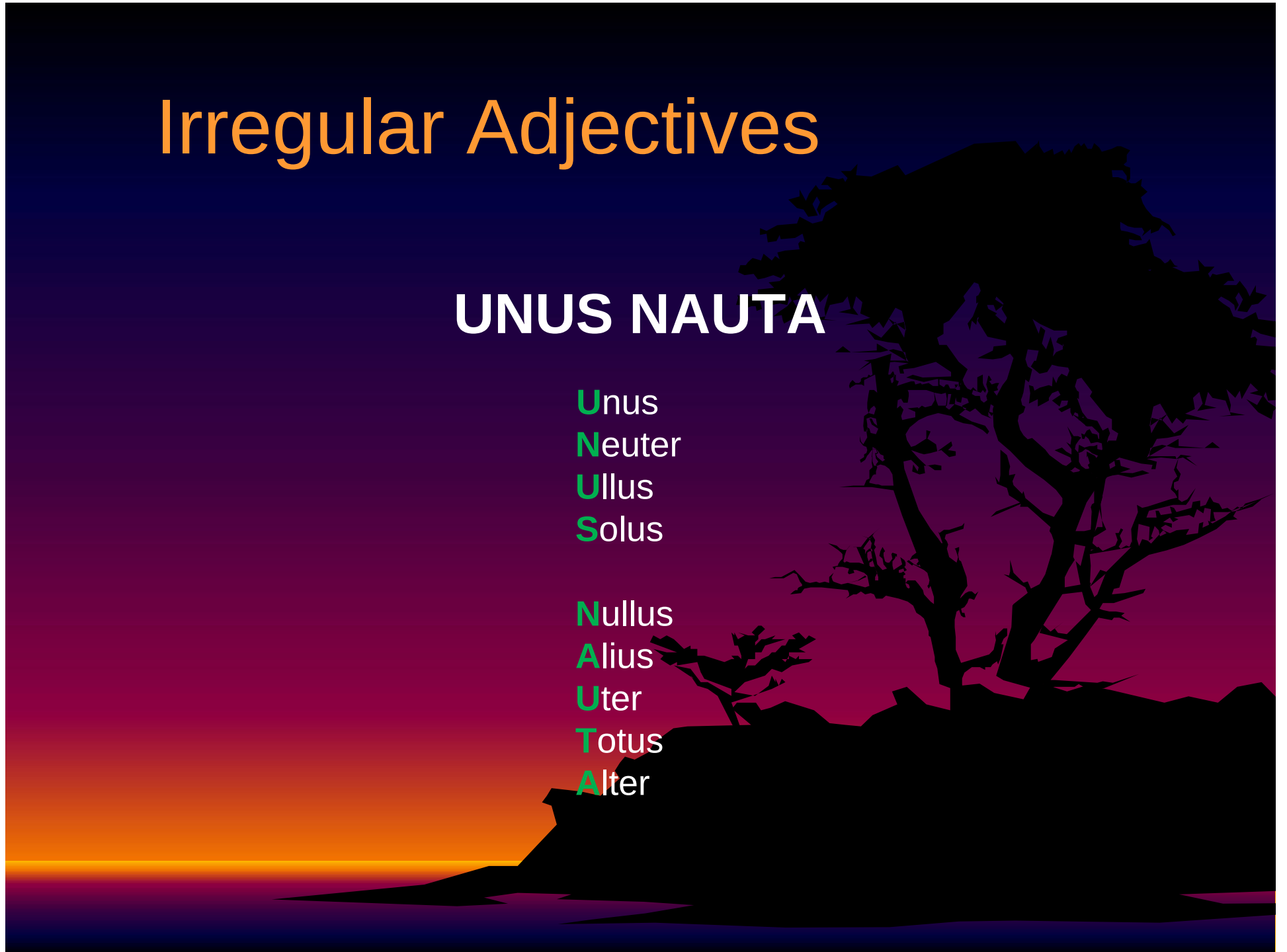

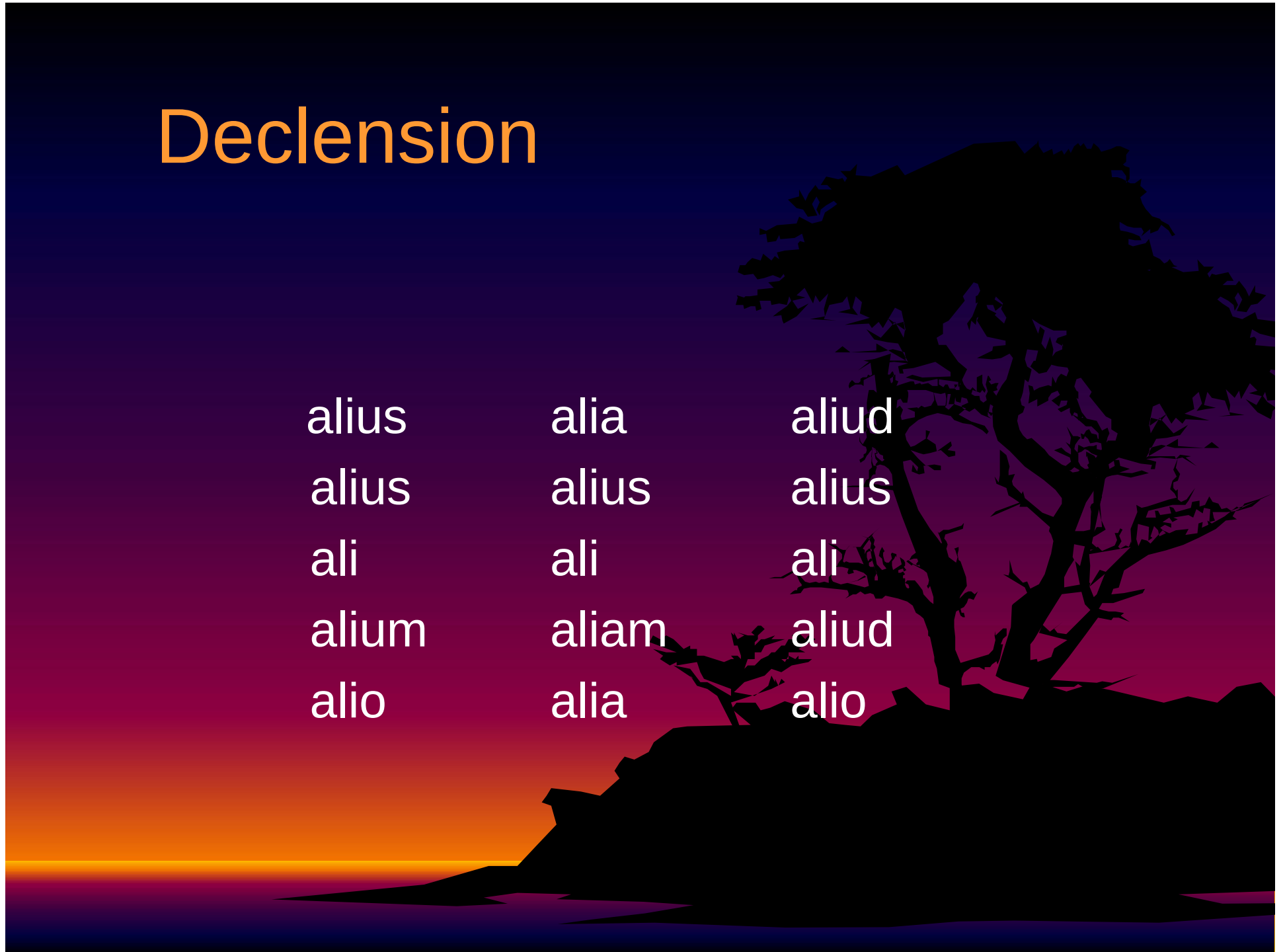

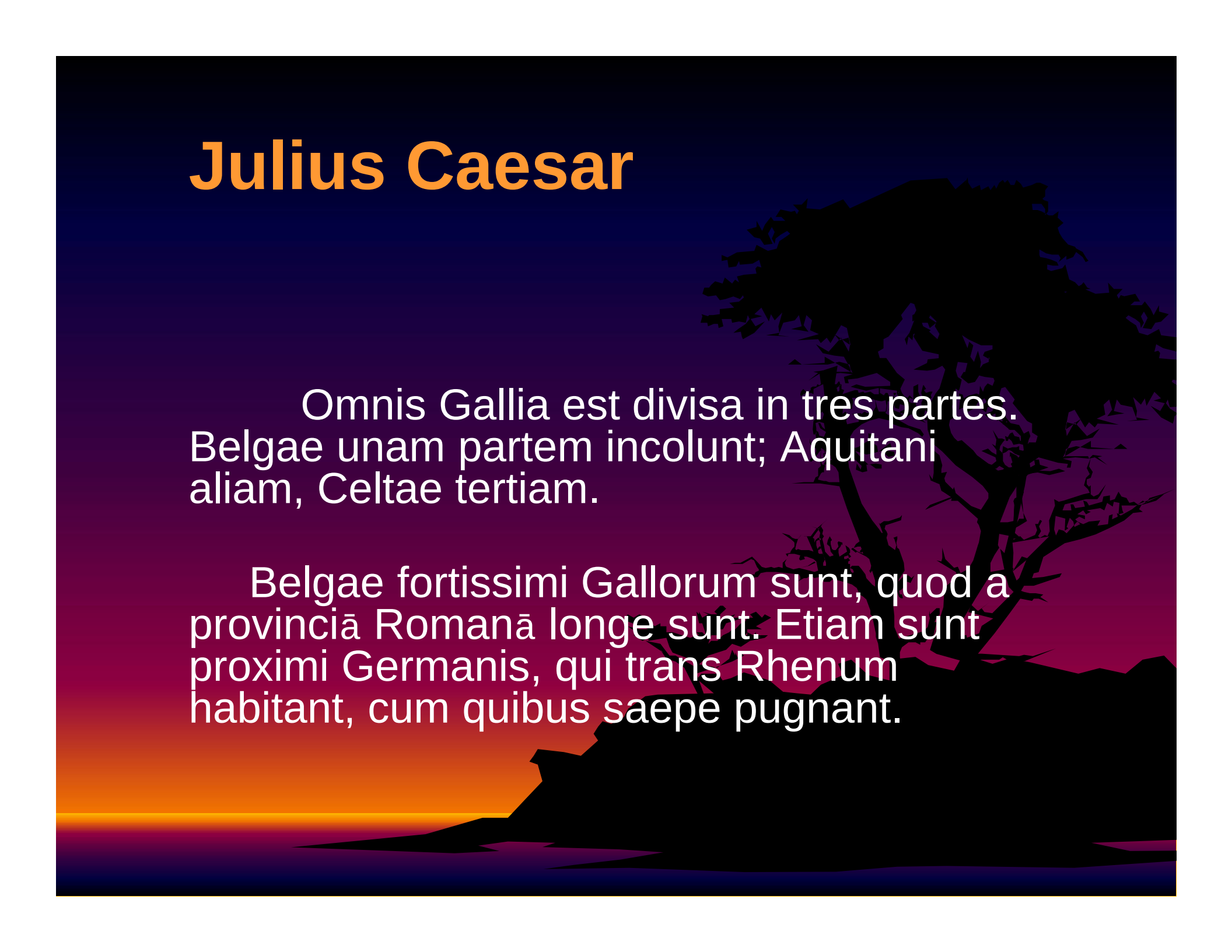
